# Essential GRNZ Welfare Records for Kennel Audits



The following documents need to be kept up to date and available for inspection during a Racing Integrity Board (RIB) kennel audit as per the **Greyhound Welfare Standards** and **Rules of Racing**.

#### STAFF INDUCTION RECORDS

All kennel staff must complete an induction in the GRNZ Rules and Welfare Standards applicable to their role, which includes all kennel safety and emergency procedures.

Greyhound Welfare Standard 1.39 applies

### TREATMENT RECORDS

Written treatment records with details of all treatments given to the greyhound, including the name and signature of the person/s administering and/or authorising the treatment, must be kept while the greyhound is in the care of a licensed person (LP) and for a minimum of two years.

GRNZ Rule 151 applies

#### **VACCINATION RECORDS**

A written record with the details of all vaccinations given to the greyhound must be kept.

GRNZ Rule 151 applies

#### **VETERINARY HEALTH RECORDS**

LPs must ensure that greyhounds in their care undergo, at least, an annual veterinary examination, which may be at the time of vaccination, and which includes a full physical and dental examination. Records of annual veterinary examinations must be kept.

#### **PRODUCT SAFETY SHEETS**

Any product used for pest and/or vermin control must be used according to the manufacturer's instructions and the safety data sheet must be kept on site, while the product is in use.

## **EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN**

A written emergency plan must be kept up to date and all staff must be familiar with it. GRNZ has produced an **Emergency Plan** template with all the relevant information required to help LPs to document arrangements for their premises during an emergency situation such as fire, flood or earthquake.

## **EXERCISE, SOCIALISATION AND ENRICHMENT (ESE) PLAN**

Every LP taking care of greyhounds is required to produce a written ESE Plan for their property for all of the different life cycle stages of the greyhounds they care for. An **ESE Plan** template, as well as **resources and information** to help LPs meet these requirements, is available on the GRNZ website.

Greyhound Welfare Standard 3.3 applies

# **VEHICLE WARRANT OF FITNESS (WOF)**

All vehicles for transporting greyhounds must hold current warrants or certificates of fitness.
