



## Consecutive Day Nomination Policy

GRNZ Rule 19.11 states that:

“A greyhound shall not be eligible to compete in more than one (1) totalisator event over any two (2) day period”.

There are occasions, however, that it is not unreasonable that a dog is nominated for races on consecutive days.

- Where a dog is a reserve for the 1<sup>st</sup> day's fields – this dog maybe nominated to start the day after. If the dog regains the field for the 1<sup>st</sup> day it **MUST** be scratched for the 2<sup>nd</sup> day – please note that the onus is on the Trainer to scratch when notified of the dog regaining the field on the 1<sup>st</sup> day.
- If a dog is a reserve for a Feature Race or Final on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day and regains the field for that race before the 1<sup>st</sup> day scratching time, the dog must start on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day i.e. the Feature Race or Final. However, if the dog has already competed on the first day it must be withdrawn from the 2<sup>nd</sup> day race.

If any dog is nominated for consecutive days with no Reserve status applicable the dog shall race on the first of the days.
