

Consecutive Day Nomination Policy

GRNZ Rule 19.11 states that:

"A greyhound shall not be eligible to compete in more than one (1) totalisator event over any two (2) day period".

There are occasions, however, that it is not unreasonable that a dog is nominated for races on consecutive days.

- Where a dog is a reserve for the 1st day's fields this dog maybe nominated to start the day after. If the dog regains the field for the 1st day it MUST be scratched for the 2nd day please note that the onus is on the Trainer to scratch when notified of the dog regaining the field on the 1st day.
- If a dog is a reserve for a Feature Race or Final on the 2nd day and regains the field for that race before the 1st day scratching time, the dog must start on the 2nd day i.e. the Feature Race or Final. However, if the dog has already competed on the first day it must be withdrawn from the 2nd day race.

If any dog is nominated for consecutive days with no Reserve status applicable the dog shall race on the first of the days.
