GRNZ SAFE WORK SITE PROTOCOLS - CAMBRIDGE RACEWAY

Special Policy for Racing Under Covid ORANGE Light, updated Thu 9 Dec 2021

BEFORE LEAVING HOME

Anybody who is feeling unwell must remain at home.

Handlers to bring their own coat/wet-weather gear.

Make sure Everyone travelling to the track with you has a Face Covering, Proof of Vaccination and have the NZ Covid Tracer App on their mobile phone.

Arrange care for children, the racetrack is a Work Site.

WHO CAN ENTER TO THE SAFE WORK SITE (CAMBRIDGE RACEWAY)

Access to meeting limited to essential staff such as licensed trainers (or trainers' reps) with dogs at the meeting, licensed handlers, stewards, vets, club and TAB NZ employees with race day duties

No tote operators.

No owners, other than those with other roles already listed.

No children.

CLUBHOUSE BAR & OTHER BUSINESSES OPERATING

The Clubhouse Bar and Restaurant will be operating under their own Protocols. LPs and other Raceday workers can enter the Clubhouse provided they satisfy Clubhouse requirements.

ON ENTERING THE SAFE WORK SITE (CAMBRIDGE RACEWAY)

Provide your My Vaccine Pass, or Proof of First Vaccination (LPs only) Scan the QR code.

KENNELLING (Face Covering MUST be worn whilst Kennelling/Retrieve from Kennel)

Split Kennelling will continue as Normal.

One door will be used for dogs going TO kennels, One door for dogs leaving the kennels Maintain 1m spacing whilst in queue for kennelling.

Pre-kennelling veterinarian exams will be conducted in open air when possible.

Greyhound ID process limited to microchip scanning, ear brand check as a last resort only.

Only handlers of Greyhounds and essential kennel staff to be in kennel block when required to be.

Handler to operate door to their dog's kennel.

Prior to handling another dog or commencing any other task, it is recommended that you use hand sanitiser or wash your hands with soap.

WALK FROM KENNEL TO BOXES

Handlers are encouraged to wear a Face Covering.

Maintain 1m spacing retrieving your greyhound from the kennel area, fitting of their rug, through stir-up, and the walk to boxes.

Aim to reach boxes 'Just in Time' for loading.

Split into Groups of Box First, Odd Numbers, Even Numbers maintaining at least 1m spacing

BOXING: 2 LINES OF 4 DOGS

Box First Dogs will continue to Box First

Two line model for loading:

Odd Numbers followed by Even numbers as normal, Maintain 1m spacing - which may require #1 & #5 slightly ahead of #3 & #7, and #2 and #6 slightly ahead of #4 and #8.

375m Handlers, who are also catching, to head to Catching Area as soon as they have loaded their dog.

After Boxing their Dog, Handlers to maintain 1m spacing.

CATCHING

Maintain 1m spacing until lure stops.

One catcher per dog.

Maintain 1m spacing whilst catching.

Return to 1m spacing once your dog is under control.

WALK OFF THE TRACK / WINNER ONLY DAIS / WASH DOWN

Maintain 1m spacing on walk back.

Winner Only Dais.

Maintain 1m spacing at wash down.

Return rug, and return dog to van/trailer or swab kennel.

Prior to handling another dog or commencing any other task, it is recommended that you use hand sanitiser or wash your hands with soap.
