



## 2021 Member Nominated Director Vacancy

The New Zealand Greyhound Racing Association, also known as Greyhound Racing New Zealand (GRNZ), is the governing body for all Greyhound Racing in New Zealand, as authorised by Racing Act 2020. GRNZ leads a small but dynamic Code working within the Racing Industry to improve the overall commercial viability of Racing for all stakeholders. This is an interesting and challenging role in an industry that is a significant contributor to the New Zealand economy.

GRNZ now seeks nominations for **one** Member Nominated Director vacancy. The term of appointment is for three years from the 17 November 2021 AGM.

**Ideally nominees will be skilled in two or more of the following areas:**

- Can champion collective board accountability for maximizing animal welfare
- Business and financial management
- Racing, especially Greyhound Racing exposure
- Governance and boardroom exposure/experience
- Project and change management experience (given the industry-wide reforms).
- Relatable to key stakeholders, especially clubs

An interest or background in greyhound racing is desirable, an understanding of how sporting bodies or membership organisations work, and an understanding of the relationship between member clubs, other stakeholders and a governing body, such as GRNZ, would be a distinct advantage.
