

GRNZ DRESS APPROVALS

Dress Code – Approvals have been granted for AGRC, WGRC, SGRC, CGRC , OGRC & LOGOS as follows:

AUCKLAND: The Club wish to allow shirts / blouses, vests and jackets. The Club would primarily use the categories (shirts / blouses, vests and jackets) and the additional combinations would only be used in variable or unseasonal weather conditions or due to health conditions of the handler.

WAIKATO: Additional rule sought to allow the following categories – shirts / blouses, shirts / blouses and or/vests, vests, vests or jackets, jackets.

SOUTHLAND: Navy blue jackets and for all 8 handlers to wear jackets or all 8 handlers wear white shirts.

In wet weather, and only by approval of the Club, - black soled gumboots and black or navy blue wet weather pants may be worn.

CHRISTCHURCH: The Christchurch Club already has GRNZ approval for ties but seeks approval for the black or white tops to be approved. The Board feels that it is a more professional image for all handlers/catchers to all be wearing either White Shirts or Jackets or Black jackets either light or heavy so they all consistent in appearance on television and live. The club has a supply of lightweight black and white jackets and heavy black jackets. This is based on a majority rules basis with handlers as weather condition dictate.

OTAGO: Club Jackets (Blue & Gold) for all 8 handlers or a combination of white shirts/blouses or white nylon parkas for all 8 handlers. The decision as to whether jackets are worn or not is based on a majority ruling for each individual race.
