Evaluation criteria for approval of an additional pregnancy

- Under exceptional circumstances, including but not limited to an exceptional racing history or unusual patterns for coming into season, an independent panel, appointed by the GRNZ Board will consider whether a breeding female should be allowed to breed one additional litter after she turns seven years of age or she may whelp a final fourth litter.
- The additional service will be final, regardless of the result. The service must take place within the first three months following receipt of approval, the veterinary health check, otherwise a new application must be made.
- In the case approval is gained to breed a fourth litter or breed a female over seven years of age, she must have been serviced prior to her 8th birthday, after which time her registration as a breeding female will become permanently inactive.
- The only exception to this is as set out in Appendix 2 of the GRNZ Policy.
