Under exceptional circumstances, including but not limited to an exceptional racing history or unusual patterns for coming into season, an independent panel, appointed by the GRNZ Board will consider whether a breeding female should be allowed to breed one additional litter after she turns eight years of age or she may whelp a final fifth litter.
