

GRNZ SAFE WORK SITE PROTOCOLS - TRIALS - ALL VENUES

Special Policy for Trials Under Covid Alert Level 3

The trials would be advertised in advance and trainers would enter their greyhounds.

Each trainer would then be allocated a time-slot to bring their dogs to the track with two or three people from their 'bubble' - one person designated as Releaser and another person designated as Catcher.

The Releaser would take the dog to the start point for the trial and signal to the lure driver (positioned in the grandstand) to start the lure. The releaser would release the greyhound to chase the lure and the catcher would then catch it when the lure slows to a stop, returning the dog to its trailer and water.

Once trainer "A" was finished they would vacate the track and trainer "B" would roll up with their greyhounds.

At regular intervals a break of 10mins would be scheduled, between trainers, for the curator to groom the track to remove paw-prints etc.

Total Club Staff Required on site: 3 (Lure Driver, Curator, Administrator - to co-ordinate)

Total Staff Required per Trainer: 2 or 3 (including trainer) (Releaser, Catcher, Assistant from same bubble)

Total Trainers likely to want to Trial: 10 to 30, BUT in sequence, NOT together.
