Hock	Pain on flexion/rotation	21-28 Days

Tendons	Ruptured, swollen back of wrist or hock	28 Days
Fractures	Case by case	28 days – 12 weeks
Thumps	If performance is adversely affected	7 Days

Fleas	Infestation (5 or more found)	Scratching and stood down pending Veterinary proof of eradication
Cramp		See Cramping policy
Race Falls	Greyhound loses footing entirely and rolls, slides or somersaults	5 Days irrespective of post-race examination
